By practicing empathy, embracing diversity, and fostering inclusive spaces, we can build lasting, respectful relationships that enrich all our lives

Six communities were successful in their funding applications in 2024, including Murchison, Merrigum, Dookie, Dhurringile, Tallygaroopna and Shepparton East. These community's shared in a funding pool of \$5,000, with the money being used for events including a tennis smash and bash session in Murchison, a movie night in Tallygaroopna, community dinner in Dhurringile, clean-up day and barbeque in Dookie, community barbeque in Shepparton East and an Easter event in Merrigum.
