- Must not have been a previous Award *winner* for the category you are intending to nominate for
- Must not nominate themselves (Individual categories only)
- Must not be volunteering as part of their employment

For the purpose of these awards, a volunteer is someone who gives their time willingly for the common good and without financial gain. (Volunteering Australia definition).
